- Prioritizing activities to meet client needs while maintaining fiscal responsibility.
- Most financial decisions related to the laboratory, including the large purchasing decisions, such as for new equipment costing more than \$1,000, after consulting with the faculty supervisor.
- Generating appropriate schedule of charges and operating the lab in a manner that is close to financial break-even.
- Interfacing with clients in providing information about the lab's capabilities, accepting and scheduling samples for analysis, providing data to the client in a format that satisfies the client's needs and billing clients for services.
