

Facilities For Your Goats

Dimensions:

- Project the largest number of goats that you would have on feed at any given time.
- A minimum of 15 square feet of barn space per goat and a minimum of 40 square feet of pen space per goat.
- Arrangement of the pens that allows ease in working with the goats on a daily basis.

Shelter Properties:

- The shed should be open to the south and closed to the north.
- Proper ventilation year round
- Feed and equipment storage outside the pen
- Washing and Grooming facilities outside of the pen
- Lighting
- Base material in pens



Fencing Properties:

- Good Woven wire or tight panels they can't squeeze through.
 - Be sure that the bottom of the fence is wired tight to prevent crawling under.
 - Fencing for pens that is predator proof

Bottom Line:

- ** Keep It Simple and Inexpensive!!
- ** Include: *Protection from the weather in a barn or shed
 - *Area for exposure to the sun and exercise.
