Show Guidelines

Show coordinators reserve the right for all show decisions to be changed for any reason if they are deemed necessary. **DECISIONS ARE FINAL!**

- All exhibitors must be active 4-H or FFA members ages 7-18 on January 1st, 2017
- Only exhibitors & their immediate family may handle their livestock
- Exhibitors must show their own animal for showmanship classes. Showmanship classes have no charge for entry.
- No limit to number of entries
- If not pre-entered, animals must be entered by specie check-in time
- Entry fee is used to defray expenses of show, NO REFUNDS!! All exhibitors must check in at registration table prior to weighing in
- Animals shown in market classes cannot be shown in breeding classes.
- Each exhibitor must provide own bedding/supplies
- All straw or wood shavings must be cleared from area used & must be put in the spreaders. If not cleaned, prizes will be forfeited.
- Cattle are not allowed to be stalled inside the exhibit barn
- Pen space is limit, be prepared to show out of trailer if necessary
- All male animals must be castrated
- For safety of all persons attending, livestock must be manageable! Unmanageable or unruly livestock can be dismissed by a decision of the show committee
- Persons showing unnecessary/rough handling of animals will be asked to leave the show and forfeit any prizes
- No clipping of animals in isles of barns at any time, come with animals clipped
- All meat goats must be tipped if they have horns
- No livestock on grounds until day of show.
- Sheep, goats & swine shown in market classes must be born after Jan. 1, 2017. Beef after Jan. 1, 2016. Bucket Calves between Jan 1 – April 1 2017.
- Market Animals must have a visible ear tag, official 4-H/FFA tag preferred
- All lambs & goats must be identified with an official USDA ID tag
- All market classes are considered prospect market animals and will be weighed and divided in classes by weight. Classes may be divided according to ring space when needed.
- Market animals of either sex will be shown together and divided by weight as needed
- Breeding classes will be divided as needed by weight for Goats, Sheep & Swine. Breeding Heifers will be divided by age.
- **Warning:** Under Kansas law, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities resulting from the inherent risk or domestic animal activities. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic animal activity. K.S.A. 60-4001 through 60-4004
- Livestock must be free of ringworm, warts, sore mouth, lamb fungus, and mange to show Animals will be inspected by a veterinarian inspector and any signs of sickness, infections, contagious or parasitic disease will result in the animals' rejection for entry. The inspectors' decision is final.
- The purpose of this show is to provide and educational experience for youth in the 4-H and FFA livestock programs
- The show committee reserves the right to clarify any rule printed and any question not covered by the listed rules and information
- Judges' decisions are final!!!

Class BF1 - Showmanship 14 & up

Class BF2 - Showmanship 10-13

Class BF3 - Showmanship 7-9

Class BF4 - Breeding Beef Heifer

Females will be divided by age depending on entry. An overall champion female will then be selected from these breeding class winners.

Class BF5 - Prospect Market Beef

Market show by weight, number of classes will be determined show day followed by selection of champion market beef.
