K-State Animal Science Leadership Academy Application Information

June 5-8, 2024

High school youth are invited to apply for the K-State Animal Science Leadership Academy hosted by the Kansas State University Department of Animal Sciences and Industry, and sponsored by the Livestock and Meat Industry Council Inc (LMIC). The goal of this academy will be to further develop young leaders within the livestock industry and prepare them for a successful future in this field.

This four-day session will focus on increasing knowledge of Kansas' diverse livestock industry, as well as building participant's leadership skills. Twenty high school students will be selected to participate in each group based upon educational, community, and agricultural involvement, as reflected through an application process.

The program's itinerary will feature interactive workshops, tours and faculty mentor time with ASI professors. Students will take a day-long bus tour and engage with industry leaders throughout Kansas. Participants will work in teams to evaluate current events within the animal science industry and educate others. This experience will culminate with a closing reception on Saturday morning.

Participants will stay on campus in university housing with program staff. Transportation to and from the event is the responsibility of the participant, along with a \$50 non-refundable fee to reserve his or her space. The fee is only due upon acceptance and not at the time of application. LMIC generously provides all other sponsorships.

Application Requirements:

- Participants must be currently (as of March 1, 2024) enrolled in high school.
- Applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2024.
- Participants must be able to participate in the entire academy and attend all conference sessions.
- Students must complete all areas of the application. The spacing of the application for responses must be unaltered and extra attachments will not be accepted.
- The application should be paper clipped including application form and resume. References may be included or mailed separately in a signed and sealed envelope.
- Students will contact Madeline Drake at mcdrake@k-state.edu to schedule the Zoom video essay portion of their application.
- Applicants will receive an email confirmation that their application has been received. Please allow two weeks for receipt and review of applicants after the April 15th deadline. Notifications will be sent via email.
