**About This Role:**

The position will be located in Manhattan, KS.

- Engage in recruitment of future students while developing active relationships with industry stakeholders

- Collaborate with the Department's Youth Livestock Program, Communications Specialist, and Extension specialists to provide and deliver impactful content for Kansas youth and stakeholders
- Support the overall mission of the Department
- Work in a diverse and multicultural environment by fostering diversity and teamwork

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- MS degree (at time of employment) with an emphasis in animal science or related field
- Experience in coaching a livestock judging team
- Evidence of being a successful team worker, able to foster diversity, ability to meet, interact and communicate with students, colleagues, staff, and other pertinent stakeholders
- Demonstrated effective oral and written communication skills
- Commitment to the University's land-grant mission

**Preferred Qualifications:**

- Evidence of success in coaching at a collegiate level
- Desire and ability to work in a multi-disciplinary team environment and advance the University's commitment to collegiality, diversity, and inclusivity
