# **Facilities For Your Goats**

### **Dimensions:**

- Project the largest number of goats that you would have on feed at any given time.
- •A minimum of 15 square feet of barn space per goat and a minimum of 40 square feet of pen space per goat.
- Arrangement of the pens that allows ease in working with the goats on a daily basis.

### **Shelter Properties:**

- The shed should be open to the south and closed to the north.
- Proper ventilation year round
- Feed and equipment storage outside the pen
- Washing and Grooming facilities outside of the pen
- Lighting
- Base material in pens

## **Fencing Properties:**

- Good Woven wire or tight panels they can't squeeze through.
  - Be sure that the bottom of the fence is wired tight to prevent crawling under.
  - Fencing for pens that is predator proof

### **Bottom Line:**

- \*\* Keep It Simple and Inexpensive!!
- \*\* Include: \*Protection from the weather in a barn or shed
  - \*Area for exposure to the sun and exercise.
