



Trade Show

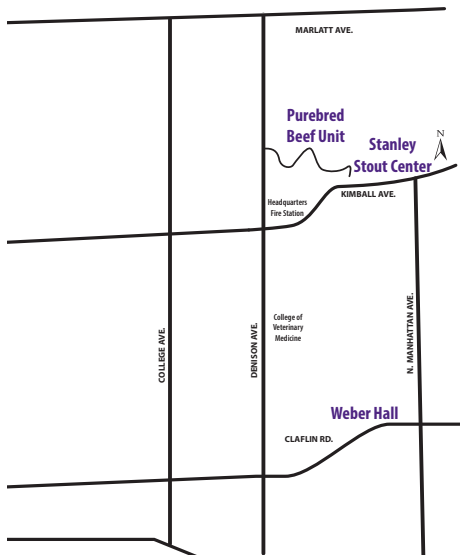
There will be numerous vendors participating in the industry trade show that opens at 8 a.m. in Weber Arena.
