General Rules:

- 1. Saturday is a FIT SHOW. Sunday is a BLOW & GO SHOW.
- 2. Open to all 4-H, FFA and Junior Association members. We will follow breed association rules.
- 3. On-line entries made by May 1: \$30 per head per show. Pay day of show for the cattle you bring. Entries made May 2 or later (including show day)will be \$40 per head per show. Showmanship will be a \$5 entry fee for each day. McPherson County 4-Hers pre-entry will be \$20 per exhibitor for the show Sunday and after May 1st will be \$30/exhibitor
- 4. Exhibitors must provide their own bedding.
- 5. All heifers & Bulls must have registration papers at check in or will show in Commercial class. Heifers must be born on or after August 1, 2022. Bulls must be January 1, 2022 or younger.
- 6. All steers must have registration papers at check in or will show in Crossbred class.
- 7. A minimum of 3 animals per breed required for breed class; otherwise they will be entered into the AOB class.
