Special Rules

1. Jefferson County Steer Class — NO FEE — All Jefferson County 4-Hers or FFA members will show in Class 22 for Jefferson County members only. Awards will be given for overall champion and reserve champion Jefferson County Steers. You must show in the regular steer class to be eligible to show in the Jefferson County Steer Class.
2. Heifers or steers shown by 4-H members must meet 4-H requirements.
3. IN ORDER TO SHOW, CATTLE NOT PRE-ENTERED MUST BE ENTERED AT ENTRY TABLE BEFORE 9 A.M.
4. *Straw/chips will be allowed in barns. Exhibitors are required to clean up their stalling area. Please be courteous and clean up your stalling area before leaving.*
5. Classes maybe divided according to ring space when needed.
6. ALL BREEDING ANIMALS will be required to have registration papers. Health papers on out-of-state breeding animals will be required.
7. All questionable steers will show as crossbred or as determined by Beef Show Committee.
8. Crossbred steers will show by weight. Weigh-in will be from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
9. All persons who attend or participate in the show do so at their own risk.
